OIL PAINTING SUPPLY LIST (cost approximately \$50+)

Brushes (synthetic sable preferred) – #1, #2, #4, #6 flats, #2 and #4 rounds

Canvasses (stretched canvasses or canvas boards) – approx. 16” X 20” (not too small and not larger than around 24” X 24”)

Turpentine (the kind from the hardware store is fine) **NO TURPENOID**

‘Mason’ type jar – to hold turpentine and clean brushes

Small bottle of linseed oil and small cup

Flexible palette knife

Palette (disposable preferred)

White plastic bags (for tables and clean-up)

Many rags

Soap for clean-up

Small sketch book

**Paint Colors... below is bare minimum needed...more is better
(‘studio’ size tubes are preferred);**

Alizarin Crimson

Burnt Sienna, Raw Sienna

Burnt Umber, Raw Umber

Cadmium Yellow

Green

Orange

Red

Violet

Ultramarine Blue

White

Yellow Ochre
