#### EVENING AT EMORY OFFERS CEUs

You will notice on our website that many classes have been specifically selected for CEU (Continuing Education Units). For those of you who are not familiar with CEUs, below are some pertinent information that will help you understand and utilize classes with CEU credits attached to them.

The CEU credit is a nationally recognized unit of measurement for participating in non-credit continuing education programs. One CEU is defined as "10 contact hours of participation in an organized continuing education experience, under responsible sponsorship, capable direction and qualified instruction." Obtaining CEUs requires minimum 80% attendance and completion of any required or make up work. Taking a class with CEUs gives adult learners an opportunity to keep up with the needs of the educational standards of their profession.
